Outstanding Achievement Award

Recognizes an achievement of a member or team by peers and possibly other organizations as extraordinary and unique. The achievement should address local government finance. (Individual and Team Award Category)

Innovative Idea Award

Recognizes originality and creativity of a program or project that has overall significance to local government. The program or project should be a financial or technical advancement, improving a process significantly with proven cost and benefits and has garnered some form of recognition within local government. (Individual and Team Award Category)

Life Member Award

Recognizes members and partners who have made significant contributions to local government. Promoting education, peer support and networking to enhance professional skills within local government. To be eligible for consideration for this award, a member or partner must have a minimum of ten (10) years membership in the Government Finance Officers Association of BC. (Individual Award Category)

Outstanding Contribution Award

Recognizes members or partners who have made a significant contribution to the Government Finance Officers Association of BC over a number of years. (Individual Award Category)
