Board members are elected annually at the AGM and typically serve on two committees supporting member services, education, and external relations.

**Executive Committee:** Supports the overall governance structure; each member serves as Chair of a committee listed below.

**Member Services Committee:** Supports member engagement initiatives, the awards program, and member knowledge-sharing platforms.

**Education Committee:** Supports professional development and education programming that meets evolving member needs.

**External Relations Committee:** Supports collaboration with governments, professional bodies, and sector partners on standards, practices, and legislation.
